Or there's the *Direttissima PEJO 3000*, a uniquely enjoyable 8 km (5 mi) ski run with a total altitude change of 1,600 m (5,250 ft) into Pejo Fonti.

Skiing, not just a winter sport. The Pontedilegno-Tonale ski area is located on the border between the Trentino and Lombardy regions and is open for skiing from autumn through spring on the Presena glacier at an altitude of 3,000 meters (9,850 ft). Pontedilegno-Tonale has 28 lifts serving 100 km (62 mi) of ski runs, all interconnected and packed with snow, thanks to the high altitude and an artificial snow system covering the entire ski area. The advanced Paradiso ski run is one of the most amazing of all the Alps and runs from the summit of the glacier all the way down to Ponte di Legno. At a length of 11 km (nearly 7 mi) of non-stop excitement, it's one of Europe's longest ski runs! The Pontedilegno-Tonale ski area also features a terrain park complete with its own ski-cross run, and the area is great for both families and young adults, who can enjoy the nightlife in the many pubs and dance clubs as well as the various chalets and mountain lodges for a more relaxing evening out.

At just 15 minutes from the motorway exit, you'll find Altopiano della Paganella, a panoramic high plain looking out over the entire Trentino region. Framed by the spires of the Brenta Dolomites, Altopiano has something for everyone! First and foremost, there's skiing and snowboarding at the modern complex of Paganella ski areas—a total of 14 from Andalo to Fai della Paganella and featuring sun-drenched, panoramic ski runs that are always perfectly groomed with the help of artificial snow. In fact, the Norwegian ski team of Svindal, Jansrud and Kristoffersen has chosen this as their base of operations for training. The ski runs here are certain to please skiers of all ages and skill levels, with 10 easy runs, 13 intermediate, 2 Olympic advanced runs—sites for international competitions—and the famous 3Tre competition alpine ski run.

The lifts, which start in Andalo and Fai della Paganella, can carry up to 27,000 skiers every hour

The Paganella ski area is also a destination for enthusiasts of freeriding, telemarking, ski mountaineering, cross-country skiing and snowshoeing. In the five towns of the high plain area—Andalo, Fai della Paganella, Molveno, Cavedago, and Spormaggiore—there are a great many lodging opportunities, from vacation apartments to family-certified hotels. Indeed, it is what the area has to offer families that is the highlight of the Paganella ski area, including: five beginner ski slopes and over 190 expert instructors, five "baby parks" for having fun in the snow, a mountain library, and a great many events designed specifically for children.
