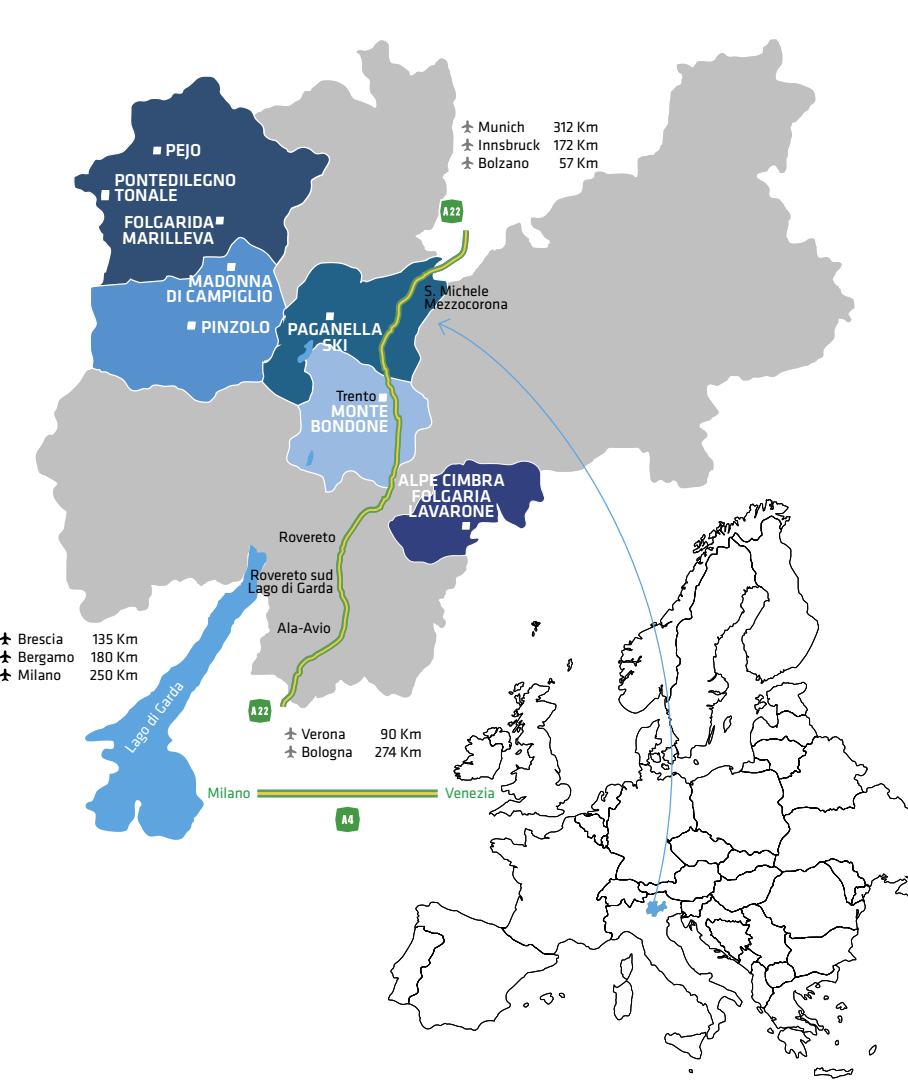

The undisputed highlight is the PEJO 3000 lift, which serves the thrilling Val della Mite downhill run, a 4 km (2.5 mi) technical descent from 3,000m (9,850 ft) through an unparalleled landscape.

Or there's the Direttissima PEJO 3000, a unique 8 km (5 mi) ski run with a total elevation difference of 1,600m (5,250 ft) into Pejo Fonti.

The CAMPIGLIO DOLOMITI DI BRENTA ski pass includes access to the PEJO 3000 ski area, which is interconnected with the other Val di Sole resorts by way of an efficient ski bus free of charge.

Skiing, not just a winter sport. The Pontedilegno-Tonale ski area is located on the border between the Trentino and Lombardy regions and is open for skiing from autumn through spring on the Presena glacier at an altitude of 3,000 meters (9,850 ft). Pontedilegno-Tonale has 28 lifts serving 100 km (62 mi) of ski runs, all interconnected and packed with snow, thanks to the high altitude and an artificial snow system covering the entire ski area. The advanced Paradiso ski run is one of the most amazing of all the Alps and runs from the summit of the glacier all the way down to Ponte di Legno. A length of 11 km (nearly 7 mi) of non-stop excitement, it's one of Europe's longest ski runs! The Pontedilegno-Tonale ski area also features a terrain park complete with its own ski-cross run, and the area is great for both families and young adults, who can enjoy the nightlife in the many pubs and dance clubs as well as the various chalets and mountain lodges for a more relaxing evening out.

In addition to downhill skiing, the Pontedilegno-Tonale ski area also includes several spectacular ski mountaineering itineraries. In Passo Tonale, it's also possible to learn how to guide a sled pulled by huskies just like a real musher or to have fun on specially designed fat bike itineraries or to also experience the thrill of gliding over the snow with a snowkite powered by the wind. Don't miss out on the magical Ice Music Festival concerts, that take place from January to March on the Presena Glacier, within an igloo using instruments made of ice: a unique experience to listen to the musical notes of ice instruments!

All slopes are connected by super modern lifts that leave directly from the towns of Andalo and Fai della Paganella. 100% snow reliability and an outstanding vertical drop of more than 1,100 meters make the Altopiano della Paganella a perfect resort for all kind of skiers offering 11 easy runs, 17 intermediate and the advanced run Olimpionica 2, used for international competitions.

Paganella Ski Area is well known to be a champions' favorite training center, too. Indeed, the Norwegian Ski Team athletes like Kristoffersen and Jansrud have been using Paganella as a training base for several years, as Aksel Lund Svindal, Bode Miller and Ted Ligety did in the past.
